SPECIALIZED CARE:

Rehabilitative exercises; prevention and treatment of bedsores; turning positioning and transfers; teaching clients proper use of assistive devices.

CLIENTS:

The services are for persons five years and older.

SERVICE FEES:

Services are charged for on an hourly basis starting at R35.00 per hour.

APD SERVICES

The Association for the Physically Disabled – Greater Johannesburg provides the following services at grassroots level:

SOCIAL WORK SERVICE to assist people with disabilities (PWD's) and their families to resolve their personal problems – both psychological and physical – and empower them to develop towards an independent lifestyle.

HOME-BASED/ATTENDANT CARE SERVICE dealing with the daily physical needs of indigent members of the community who are permanently or temporarily disabled.

DAVEYTON EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT AND MOTIVATION CENTRE, which provides assessment and stimulation services for young children with disabilities and training of their families.

PROTECTIVE WORKSHOPS, which are safe, disabled-friendly environments providing opportunities for PWD's to develop and improve their skills and to earn an income to supplement their pensions.

LEAN ON US HOME CARE AGENCY. An agency offering basic and specialized care to meet the essential and personal hygiene needs of temporarily and permanently disabled people.

SKYWARD EMPLOYMENT SERVICE, which prepares PWD's for the open labour market and identifies employment opportunities for PWD's.

OPERATION MOBILITY. Wheelchair repair and rental service to members of the public as well as to private and public sector companies/organisations.

BARRIER BREAKERS (BB) has public awareness campaigns designed to break down barriers between PWD's and able-bodied individuals of all ages. It also assists employers with all aspects of diversity training and facilitation/accommodation issues pertinent to PWD's. Income generated in aid of service delivery to PWD's.
